English 115: University Writing and Research

An introduction to critical thinking and reading, academic writing, and research skills, consistent with the conditions and expectations students encounter as readers and writers at university.

Program Delivery

Students registered in English 115 will have the opportunity to acquire post secondary credit while still enrolled in high school. This course will be taught at VIU outside of the Brooks schedule. English 115 will be offered in January 2012.

Admission Requirements

- Successful completion of Grade 12 English with a minimum “C” or equivalent (LPI)
- Referral Brooks Career Education Coordinator
- Release of Information form
- Interview with VIU instructor

How to Apply

Consult with Brooks Career Education Counsellor for referral to the program. Your referral to the program will be reviewed and if approved, you will be contacted by VIU regarding the admission process.

Fees

Program tuition is covered by School District 47. ***Students are responsible for the purchase of textbooks.*** If you are not able to purchase your own textbooks, loaner textbooks will be available through School District 47.
